As you likely know, the public health and safety concerns over the Coronavirus (COVID-19) has had a major impact on many community events and venues over the last couple of weeks. The venue where we perform, The Smith Center, announced today that it has closed its campus March 15-31, thus suspending many scheduled performances.

Due to continued public health concern and in the best interest of our patrons, musicians, staff and others, we regretfully must cancel our upcoming concert, Kurt Weill's America, which was scheduled for Saturday, April 4 in Reynolds Hall.

Because as a non-profit organization we rely on ticket sales and donations, if you are in a position to donate back the price of your tickets, this will greatly aid the organization to ensure that as soon as it is possible, we will be back in the concert hall and continuing our music education and enrichment visits to schools and senior centers.
